

## Relying Party Agreement

This Relying Party Agreement ("Agreement") is entered into by and between TendaWorld Limited (trading as JULICA CA) ("JULICA", "we", "us", "our") and any person or entity that relies upon a certificate issued by JULICA ("Relying Party", "you", "your").

By relying on any JULICA-issued certificate (including but not limited to verifying a digital signature, authenticating a party, or encrypting data), you agree to be bound by this Agreement, the JULICA Certificate Policy (CP), Certification Practice Statement (CPS), and all referenced policies.

### 1. Agree

You may rely on JULICA certificates only under the terms of this Agreement.

### 2. Meaning of Terms

Unless otherwise defined, all capitalized terms used in this Agreement will have the meanings given to them in the JULICA Certificate Policy and Certification Practice Statement (CP/CPS).

### 3. Legal Relationship

This Agreement does not create any attorney-client, partnership, joint venture, or fiduciary relationship between you and JULICA. JULICA is an independent provider of certification services.

### 4. Provision, Access and Use

You may rely on JULICA certificates via any supported means (e.g., signature verification, authentication, or encryption) solely in accordance with this Agreement and the CP/CPS.

### 5. Obligations of the Relying Party

You must:

- Perform all verification steps required in the CP/CPS before relying on a certificate, including but not limited to: a. Verification of the issuer's signature; b. Checking policy parameters and certificate extensions; c. Verifying usage parameters (key usage and extended key usage); d. Confirming the certificate is within its validity period; e. Checking revocation or suspension status using CRL or OCSP; f. Verifying compliance with any critical extensions.
- Limit reliance to the scope, intended uses, and reliance limit specified in the certificate and CP/CPS.
- Not rely on the certificate if any verification step fails or if you have reason to believe the certificate is invalid, revoked, suspended, or compromised.
- Use the certificate only for lawful purposes consistent with its intended use as defined in the CP/CPS.
- Notify JULICA promptly of any suspected compromise or misuse of a certificate you have relied upon.

### 6. Your Warranties

You warrant that:

1. You have full legal power, authority, and capacity to enter into this Agreement and to rely on the certificate.
2. You will comply with all obligations under this Agreement, the CP/CPS, and applicable laws.
3. Your reliance on the certificate will not violate any third-party rights.
4. You will not use or rely on the certificate for any prohibited purpose under the CP/CPS.

### 7. Our Warranties

JULICA warrants that:

1. It has full legal power and authority to issue certificates under its CP/CPS.
2. It will issue and manage certificates in substantial accordance with the published CP/CPS.

### **8. Confidential Information**

Any confidential information exchanged in connection with reliance on certificates shall be protected in accordance with the CP/CPS and Data Protection Policy.

### **9. Disclaimers**

JULICA certificates and services are provided "AS IS". Except as expressly stated in the CP/CPS, JULICA disclaims all representations and warranties, whether express, implied, or statutory, including but not limited to merchantability, fitness for a particular purpose, accuracy, and non-infringement.

### **10. Indemnification**

You will defend, indemnify, and hold JULICA, its officers, directors, employees, and agents harmless from and against any claims, damages, losses, liabilities, and expenses arising out of your breach of this Agreement, misuse of a certificate, or failure to perform required verification steps.

### **11. Liability**

Our liability is limited as set out in the CP/CPS. To the maximum extent permitted by law, JULICA's total aggregate liability to any Relying Party shall not exceed the reliance limit specified in the relevant certificate or the amount (if any) paid by the Relying Party for the transaction, whichever is lower. JULICA shall not be liable for any indirect, incidental, special, consequential, or punitive damages.

### **12. Force Majeure**

JULICA will not be liable for any delay or failure to perform any obligation where the delay or failure results from any cause beyond our reasonable control.

### **13. Communication between Parties**

Both parties agree to use the contact details provided in the CP/CPS or the official repository for all communications.

### **14. Assignment**

You may not assign or transfer this Agreement without JULICA's prior written consent.

### **15. Entire Agreement**

This Agreement, together with the CP/CPS, Data Protection Policy, and any referenced documents, constitutes the entire agreement regarding your reliance on JULICA certificates.

### **16. Modifications to Agreement**

We may modify this Agreement at any time by posting the modified version in the official JULICA repository. Continued reliance on certificates after such posting constitutes acceptance of the modified Agreement.

### **17. Dispute Resolution, Applicable Law and Jurisdiction**

Disputes shall be resolved in accordance with the dispute resolution procedures in the CP/CPS. This Agreement is governed by the laws of the Republic of Kenya.

### **18. Severability**

If any provision of this Agreement is held invalid, illegal, or unenforceable, the remaining provisions shall remain in full force and effect.
